Re: 2007 Consumer Confidence Report

Dear Mr. Welsch:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received the 2007 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for Green Acres MHP on June 25, 2008. The CCR was reviewed for the required content. Based on our review, the Green Acres MHP water system is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with the CCR requirements. The following minor violations were noted:

1. The Table of Detected Contaminants did not contain required information. The lead and copper detections reported must include a statement that documents 0 of the 5 samples did not exceeded the action levels for each of the contaminants. Antimony, Arsenic, Beryllium, Cadmium, Chromium, Cyanide, Mercury, Nickel, Selenium, Thallium, Alachlor, Atrazine, Simazine, and Radium-228 were all non-detect and should not be reported in the table. The Volatile Organic Chemicals head should not have a level found or violation information associated with it. The Haloacetic Acids level found was reported inaccurately.
2. The Total Chlorine residual levels must be reported in the table. (These levels can be found on the Total Chlorine Residual Quarterly Operating Reports, form 5114.)

Be sure to correct the violations as appropriate in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2008 must be sent to your customers by no later than July 1, 2009. A copy of the CCR along with a Certification Form must be submitted to the Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office at the above address. Violations in future reports may result in further enforcement action.
