

Subject: CCR Violations for the 2006 Reporting Year

Dear Mr. Beilharz:

Ohio EPA received the 2006 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for the Christi Water System, Inc. on August 2, 2007. The CCR was reviewed for the required content. Based on our review, the Christi Water System is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with the CCR requirements. The following violations were noted:

1. OAC Rule 3745-96-04 states the CCR must be delivered to your consumers no later than July 1st annually and a copy of the report must be sent to the Ohio EPA, NWDO no later than July 1st annually. Correct this with your next report.
2. The Table of Detected Contaminants did not include all the required information:
 - a. Copper units are expressed incorrectly. It should be in ppm, not ppb.
 - b. Include Total Chlorine residual levels in the table. (These levels can be found on the Quarterly Total Chlorine Residual Operating Report Form 5114 which is on our website at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/ddagw/drinkforms.htm>.)
 - c. Total Coliform bacteria is reported incorrectly in the table.
3. The mandatory language is not all in the report. Correct this for your next report.
4. Christi Water System, Inc. contact information is not available in the report. Your consumers must be able to contact you regarding their drinking water concerns.

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
5. The Turbidity information was not included in the report. Your parent company must monitor for turbidity and this information must be reported in your report also.

Be sure to correct the violations as appropriate in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2007 must be sent to your customers by no later than July 1, 2008. A copy of the CCR, along with a Certification Form, must be submitted to the Northwest District Office at the above address by July 1st of each year. Violations in future reports may result in further enforcement action.
