Notice of Violations – Monthly & Quarterly Reports

Dear Mr. Liette:

The following three reports were received late by the Ohio EPA-Northwest District Office (NWDO) on July 22, 2010: 1) the June 2010 Plant – Distribution Monthly Operation Report (EPA Form 5002); 2) the June 2010 Bromate Monthly Operational Report (EPA Form 5116); and 3) the 2nd calendar quarter Total Chlorine Residual Quarterly Operating Report (EPA Form 5114).

Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-83-01 (I) (2) requires that operational reports be submitted to NWDO no later than the tenth of the month following the month/calendar quarter for which the reports were prepared. This rule also requires reports to be signed by the designated operator in responsible charge in accordance with rule 3745-7-02 of the Administrative Code.

It was noted that the reports were not signed by the designated operator in responsible charge, but by you, Randall P. Liette.

More than one operator of record may be designated to oversee the technical operation of the public water system by completion and return of the enclosed Operator of Record Notification Form to the Operator Certification Unit.

Additionally, regarding EPA Form 5002, a monthly split-sample for iron was not analyzed by an in-house test kit and by a certified laboratory. The reporting period was also incorrectly completed.


