Subject: 2009 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) Violation (Type 72)

Dear Mr. Gladden:

Ohio EPA-Northwest District Office (NWDO) received the 2009 CCR for the Genoa Village public water system (PWS) on April 12, 2010. Based on our review, the Genoa Village PWS is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with all of the CCR requirements. The following violation was noted:

- A section of required additional educational information was omitted. Language specified in OAC rule 3745-96-02 (G) (1) (a) was to have been included in the CCR as follows:

"The sources of drinking water both tap water and bottled water includes rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, reservoirs, springs, and wells. As water travels over the surface of the land or through the ground, it dissolves naturally-occurring minerals and, in some cases, radioactive material, and can pick up substances resulting from the presence of animals or from human activity."


Be sure to correct the violation as needed in your next CCR. As a reminder, the report for calendar year 2010 must be sent to your customers by no later than July 1, 2011. A copy of the CCR and a completed Certification Form must be submitted to NWDO by no later than July 1, 2011.
