

**SUBJECT: 2008 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) Violations**

Dear Mr. Neff:

The Ohio EPA-Northwest District Office (NWDO) received the 2008 CCR for the Oak Harbor Village public water system (PWS) on April 8, 2009. The CCR was reviewed for the required content. Based on our review, the Oak Harbor Village PWS is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-96-01 through 04 for failure to comply with CCR requirements, the following violations were noted:

1. **Some or all of the required source water information was missing.** Refer to page one, second paragraph of the Ottawa County Regional 2008 CCR for the required source water information.
2. **Specific entry point data from the 'Table of Detected Contaminants' for the Ottawa County Regional Water System was not included in the CCR.** Refer to page 2 of the Ottawa County Regional 2008 CCR for the required detected data (text highlighted in yellow) that was to have been included in your CCR.
3. **Information for the monitoring and detection of Cryptosporidium in the source water by the Ottawa County Regional PWS was not included.** Refer to the highlighted text at the bottom of page 2 of the Ottawa County Regional 2008 CCR.
3. **A list of locations where the CCR was posted in the Village, which made a 'Good Faith' effort to reach non-bill paying customers, was not included** when your Certification Form was submitted to NWDO.


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Be sure to correct the violation as appropriate in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2009 must be sent to your customers by no later than July 1, 2010. A copy of the CCR along with a Certification Form must be submitted to NWDO at the above address. Violations in future reports may result in further enforcement action.
