Subject: Consumer Confidence Report 2009

Dear Mr. Wiebe:

Ohio EPA received the 2009 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for the Village of Paulding on July 6, 2010 . The CCR was reviewed for the required content. Based on our review, the Village of Paulding public water system is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-96-01 through 3745-96-04 for failure to comply with the CCR requirements. The following violations were noted.

The public water system failed to report the violation of the terms of an administrative order that was issued on October 26, 2006. The Village of Paulding failed to award the contract for construction of a new water plant by December 24, 2009. The CCR must note any violation that occurred during the year covered by the report of a requirement, and include a clear and readily understandable explanation of the violation, any potential adverse health effects, and the steps the community water system has taken to correct the violation. [rule 3745-96-02(F)(7)]

The public water system failed to provide the CCR and certification to the District Office by July 1, 2010. The CCR and certification were received on July 6, 2010. [rules 3745-96-04(C)(1 & 2)]

Be sure to correct the violations as appropriate in your next CCR. The next report for calendar year 2010 must be sent to your customers and Ohio EPA Northwest District by July 1, 2011. A copy of the CCR along with a Certification Form must be submitted to the Northwest District Office.
