NOTICE OF VIOLATION – ACTION REQUIRED

Fostoria Mobile Estates is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for failure to comply with total coliform monitoring requirements

Monitoring Period:	July, 2008
Required Coliform Monitoring:	Five (5) Routine Samples following June 26 th Total Coliform Positive Sample
Sample Results Submitted:	None

To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system, monitoring for total coliforms is essential. **Routine monitoring for the month of August is required.**

ACTION REQUIRED:

- 1. Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served. The appropriate methods for your system are listed below under the **Community** column.

Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.


2. **Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to Ohio EPA - Northwest District Office. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published or posted.

NOTE:

- **By August 22, 2008 provide verification that the Water Use Advisory was issued as required in our July 15, 2008 Notice of Violation (copy attached).**
- **The Water Use Advisory shall remain in effect until one set of four (4) repeat samples are found to be Total Coliform Negative.**
- **Issuance of the Water Use Advisory must be repeated every 30 days for as long as the violation exists. Submit a copy of each notice issued along with the Verification form to this office.**

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements were not met for Fostoria Mobile Estates

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. **PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR
COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 3 VIOLATIONS**

The owner or operator of a community public water system with a Tier 3 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but **no later than one year** after the system learns of the violation. At a minimum, community public water systems must issue the notice by **mail or other direct delivery**. Public notice issued by methods other than posting shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
