RE: Notice of Violation – Monthly Report

The May 2011 Drinking Water Operation Report (EPA 5002) for Northwestern Water and Sewer District-Bairdstown was received on June 8, 2011.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-83-01(C)(1) requires a system which adds chlorine to maintain a minimum of 0.2 mg/l free chlorine residual or 1.0 mg/l combined chlorine residual measured at representative points throughout the distribution system. A review of May 2011 reveals eight (8) days during the month a chlorine residual was not being maintained in the distribution system. Take steps to immediately correct this problem.

OAC Rule 3745-83-01(I)(1) requires a system to report free chlorine residual and combined chlorine residual daily on the monthly operational report from the plant tap and in distribution.
