Mr. Goudy:

On September 12, 2012, I performed an inspection of Plating Technologies, Inc. The purpose of the inspection was to determine your progress in abating the violations of Ohio's hazardous waste rules cited in my August 6, 2012, letter. You, Arsenio Fletcher, and Daniel Ott represented Plating Technologies. In addition to the facility inspection, I also reviewed facility inspection records and lists of emergency equipment. Additionally, I phoned your corporate waste manager, David Boogaard, to review the waste profile for the F006 waste. You and I also exchanged emails discussing your progress.

My inspection and review of documentation reveals that Plating Technologies, Inc. has now abated all violations discovered during the September 12, 2012, inspection as listed below.


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GENERAL COMMENTS
