**SUBJECT: Notice of Violation - Failure to Sample Drinking Water for Lead and Copper.**

Scioto Sign Company, Inc. public water supply system is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-86 for failure to comply with triennial lead and copper drinking water tap sampling requirements.

**Monitoring Period:** June - September, 2007  
**Report Due:** October 10, 2007  
**Report Received:** REPORT NOT SUBMITTED

If Lead and Copper Samples were collected during this monitoring period, complete the enclosed forms and mail, along with the laboratory analyses reports, to this office immediately. If the samples were not collected, follow the steps outlined below.

**Actions required as a result of the above violation:**

1. **Issue public notification:** Within 30 days of the date of this letter, issue a public notification as required by OAC Rule 3745-81-32. An example public notification is enclosed.
2. **Method of notification:**

**Use one or more of the following methods to reach all persons served by the public water system:**

Public notice issued by posting in conspicuous locations throughout the distribution system (required to remain posted for as long as the violation exists, but in no case less than 7 days). Schools should also send a copy of the notice to the parents of all students.

Public notice issued by mail or other direct delivery to each customer and service connection (where known).

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
**If the above methods do not reach all persons served**, also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons served by the system (e.g. publication in a local newspaper or newsletter, use of e-mail to notify employees or students, or delivery of multiple copies to central locations).

3. **Verification to Ohio EPA:** Mail this office a copy of your public notice as issued, along with the verification form within 10 days after you notify your water users.

**To return to compliance for the June - September 2007 monitoring period, collect samples from five (5) sites during June, July, August, or September 2008 and submit report forms to the Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office by October 10, 2008.**
