Lafarge North America, Inc is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for failure to comply with total coliform monitoring requirements

Monitoring Period: First Quarter of 2008
Required Coliform Monitoring: One (1) Routine sample each Quarter
Sample Results Submitted: None

To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system, monitoring for total coliforms is essential.

ACTION REQUIRED:

- 1. Notify the people served by this water system using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served. The appropriate methods for your system are listed below under the NTNC column.



## DRINKING WATER NOTICE

### Monitoring requirements were not met for Lafarge North America, Inc

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During First Quarter of 2008, we "did not monitor or test" or "did not complete all monitoring or testing" for total coliform bacteria and, therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

#### What Should I Do?
