Dear Mr. Martin:

On August 29, 2002 Ohio EPA sent Delphi Automotive Systems L.L.C. (Delphi) a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter regarding violations and deficiencies observed in Delphi's quarterly reports from sampling performed during the year 2000 and 2001. These quarterly reports are submitted as part of the on-going ground water monitoring program, and are reviewed for technical adequacy in meeting the ground water monitoring requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). By letter dated September 30, 2002 Delphi responded to Ohio EPA's NOV letter, submitting documentation and discussions regarding the issues raised in the NOV. While most of the violations were adequately addressed in Delphi's response, the remainder of the outstanding violations have been abated through the submittal and subsequently approved revised groundwater sampling and analysis plan found in Section I2 of Delphi's Part B hazardous waste operating permit renewed on October 19, 2005.

My review of this information reveals that Delphi has adequately abated the following violations cited in Ohio EPA's August 29, 2002 NOV letter:

OAC 3745-54-97(C) General ground water monitoring requirements
OAC 3745-54-97(D)(4) General ground water monitoring requirements

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve Delphi from the responsibility of complying with all applicable hazardous waste regulations. This letter does not relieve Delphi from liability for any past or present violations of the state's hazardous waste laws.
