Dear Mr. Thomas:

On March 6, 2008, Ohio EPA conducted a complaint investigation at 20100 St. Clair Ave. Euclid, Ohio. The property was formerly known as Cleveland Trencher Company. The investigation was initiated upon receipt of a complaint which alleged 40 to 50 drums of unknown material were being stored on the east side of the property. Kris Coder and I represented Ohio EPA during the site visit.

In a phone conversation with you on March 6, 2008, Ohio EPA learned that the property was acquired during a foreclosure action after Cleveland Trencher Company could no longer meet their financial obligations. In addition, you gave Kris Coder and I permission to enter the property to investigate the complaint. During the investigation, Ohio EPA learned that the facility had closed and was undergoing an asbestos removal. Ohio EPA found that a portion of the building had been removed.

Ohio EPA walked the property and found 40 – 50 (55-gallon) drums of an unknown material on the eastern portion of the property. In the phone conversation on March 6, 2008, you stated you weren't aware that the drums were there as well as what is in the containers.

As a result of our investigation, Ohio EPA found the following violation:

Waste Evaluation
OAC 3745-52-11

You, as the property owner, failed to evaluate the material in these drums to determine if it is a hazardous waste.

To abate this violation, the containers of unknown material would need to be evaluated within 45 days of the date of this letter. Any material determined to be a hazardous waste would need to be disposed at a permitted hazardous waste facility.
