

Subject: Notice of Violation for Failure to Obtain Plan Approval

Dear Pastor Radebaugh:

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-91-02(A) states, "No person shall begin construction or installation of a public water system, or make a substantial change in a public water system, until plans therefore have been approved by the director of environmental protection unless exempted ..."

The installation of the well without detail plans having been approved by the Director constitutes a continuous violation of Section 6109.07 of the Revised Code and Chapter 3745-91 of the OAC. Violations of the State's safe drinking water laws may result in litigation and the imposition of civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day of violation.

Detail plans need to be submitted immediately. Included with this correspondence is a listing of plan submittal requirements needed for plan approval and some forms that you will need with your submittal.
