Dear Mr. Bennett:

The Plant – Distribution Monthly Operation Report (MOR) (EPA Form 5002) for the April 2010 reporting period failed to report daily free and combined chlorine residual at the point of entry to the distribution system and a location representative of the distribution system and hardness weekly at the point of entry to the distribution system.

OAC 3745-83-01(G)(1) and (2) require a transient noncommunity public water system, serving 1,000 or more persons, to monitor for free and combined chlorine residual at least once every day that water is available to the public at each entry point to the distribution system and a representative point in the distribution system. On thirteen days, one or more chlorine residuals were not reported.

OAC 3745-83-01(G)(8)(b) requires a public water system, serving 250 or more persons and provides treatment to reduce hardness, shall monitor for hardness at least weekly. If hardness was monitored for weekly but the laboratory analysis was not available at the time the report was completed, a comment stating such may be added to the report and an amended report filed upon receipt of the laboratory analysis. This matter should also be discussed with your laboratory to investigate a means to have the results available for you to report on time.

Failure to take action to address these violations may result in enforcement action being taken.
