**Subject: Failure to Sample Drinking Water for Total Coliform as Required**

Clinton Lake Camping #2 is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for failure to comply with the total coliform monitoring requirements.

**Monitoring Period:** April – June 2008  
**Required Coliform Monitoring:** One (1) sample per quarter  
**Sample Results Submitted:** None

To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system monitoring for total coliforms is essential.

**ACTION REQUIRED:**

If total coliform samples were collected as required, submit the results as soon as possible. The monitoring violation would be rescinded and a reporting violation given for late submittal of the results.
