The inspector knocked on the front door and rang the doorbell. No one answered. The house is yellow and is on the southwest corner of 12th St. SW and Shadyside SW in Canton. There is a 6 foot privacy fence around the back yard. No fire was burning. There was a fire pit made of concrete blocks. The fire pit area was less than the maximum area listed in OAC 3745-19-03. No fire was burning. There was burned up wood in the fire pit. The inspector could not see down into the pit to see if there was any remnants of "junk" that were burnt.
