Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on July 2, 2012. You submitted this information in response to my June 2, 2010, Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance. In your response letter, you included copies of analytical reports of the used oil contaminated soil (non-hazardous), and a statement stating that from now on you will be managing your used light bulbs as universal waste. The bulbs will be processed by Environmental Recycling, Bowling Green, Ohio.

My review of this documentation reveals that Amos Motor & RV has abated the violations discovered during the May 19, 2010, complaint investigation/inspection and cited in my June 2, 2010, Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance as listed below:
