

### Re: WARNING LETTER: ILLEGAL OPEN BURNING

Dear Ms Curlutu:

The Canton City Health Department, Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) represents the Ohio EPA in air quality matters within Stark County. As such, APCD employees are charged with the responsibility of investigating and enforcing Ohio EPA (OEPA) air pollution regulations.

This office received notice, from the Canton City Fire Department, of a fire on your property. According to this report the fire was a yard waste fire containing freshly cut tree branches. Please be advised that this fire is in violation of Ohio EPA regulation: Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03 because the fire was set for the purpose of waste disposal (tree trimmings).

There will be no EPA fines or enforcement at this time, but be aware that future violations can incur fines of \$250 per day per violation.
