Re: WARNING LETTER RE: POSSIBLE ILLEGAL OPEN BURNING

Dear Mr. Cottrell:

The Canton City Health Department, Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) represents the Ohio EPA in air quality matters within Stark County. As such, APCD employees are charged with the responsibility to investigate and enforce Ohio EPA (OEPA) air pollution regulations.

This office received notice from the Canton City Fire Department of several unauthorized fires on your property. This letter is to inform you that any "open burning" on private property must meet Ohio EPA guidelines as described in Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03 "Open burning in restricted areas".

You are hereby advised that these fires may have been conducted in violation of the above mentioned Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03 "Open burning in restricted areas". Please be aware that any future violations can incur fines of \$250 per day per violation.
