Complaint Investigation
Notice of Violation & Return-to-Compliance**

Dear Mr. Smiley:

On June 22, 2012, Ohio EPA received an anonymous complaint regarding the Core Systems, LLC (CS) facility located at 420 Douglas Street, Mt. Gilead, OH in Morrow County. The anonymous complainant alleged an unknown oil was spilling onto the ground from totes and that there are materials stored that cause a toxic release when the materials come into contact.

On August 7, 2012, I went to the CS facility and met with you and Mr. Mark Reynolds and conducted a thorough investigation. We discussed the complaint allegations and reviewed facility operations and associated documentation. Based on the results of this investigation, it has been determined that CS violated the following used oil rule, as found in Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC):

OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators:
Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities must be labeled or clearly marked with the words "Used Oil."

Totes (~300 gallons each) of used oil located at the rear of the facility on a concrete area were not labeled as required at the time of the investigation. On this same day and in my presence, all totes of used oil were appropriately labeled. None of these totes of used oil were found to be leaking.

No further action regarding this violation is necessary at this time and CS is also returned to compliance with this letter.

COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION – FIELD ACTIVITY REPORT

On June 22, 2012, an anonymous complaint was forwarded through Ohio EPA's spill hot-line representative, Greg Lauck, to me that had originated from the U.S. EPA spill hot-line. The anonymous complainant indicated that Core Systems, located at 420 Douglas Street, Mt. Gilead, OH 43338, was spilling an unknown oil onto the ground from totes. The complainant also reported that there are materials stored that cause a toxic release when the materials come into contact.

Upon receipt of this complaint, I called Mr. Joe Edwards, Morrow County EMA/Homeland Security director. Mr. Edwards said he was well aware of the Core Systems facility and reported that he did not know of any active releases and/or sloppy operations ongoing at the location. The facility has not requested receipt of a hazardous waste generator identification number (not required).

On August 7, 2012, I went to the Core Systems facility and spoke with Mr. Mike Smiley (Plant Manager) and Mr. Mark Reynolds (Master Mechanic) about facility operations. It was reported that there are two (2) manufacturing facilities in Ohio (Painesville & Mt. Gilead). Core Systems is reported to be a "total solutions provider" for the injection molding industry. The Mt. Gilead factory specializes in plastic parts which are supplied to industries such as Whirlpool, Bosch, and Big John. It was also reported that two (2) individuals had recently been relieved from duties and OSHA had already been to the facility for an investigation and reportedly found no irregularities.

No painting is done at this facility. Injection molding machines and associated equipment are serviced on-site. A small facility maintenance shop is located within the facility. A ZEP parts cleaner, which contains 143 degree F flash solvent, is serviced/managed by ZEP. Aerosol cleaners/degreaser products are also used by the maintenance staff. Machine oils are accumulated in ~300 gallon totes and are stored at the rear of the property on concrete while awaiting off-site recycling for eventual reuse. These containers of used oil were found to be closed and not leaking, but were not labeled with the words "used oil," as required. These containers were appropriately labeled in my presence on the day of the investigation.

We also discussed management of aerosol cans, spent wipers, spent light bulbs and other universal wastes, electronic/computer equipment, and used oil filters. I said I would provide documentation associated with the applicable/best management practices available for these items.

The complaint was determined to be unfounded.
