Dear Mr. Pavarini:

On December 2, 2011, Ohio EPA, Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), visited K P Auto Wrecking, Inc. (K P Auto) located at 3000 Rockefeller Road in Cleveland, Ohio to conduct a complaint inspection. The findings of the inspection were provided to you in Ohio EPA's January 5, 2012, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. Subsequently, on February 2, May 1, May 31 and August 15, 2012, I conducted follow up inspections at your facility to determine your progress on addressing the violation of OAC rule 3745-52-11.

On January 19, 2012, you provided documentation that the 5-gallon pails contained paint which was sold for its intended purpose. On January 19, June 8 and July 2, 2012, I received waste evaluation information concerning the contents of the 55-gallon drums. On April 13, 2012, you provided documentation that the above-ground storage tank contained gas which will be used for its intended purpose.

On January 30, August 14 and August 28, 2012, KP Auto shipped the contents of the 55-gallons drums to off-site facilities for management.

Based upon submitted documentation, KP Auto has adequately addressed the violation of OAC rule 3745-52-11.
