Dear Mr. Fleming:

This letter is inform you that the Cree Park public water system is in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6109.07 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-91 for failure to submit detail plans for the water system. ORC Chapter 6107.09 (A) states "No person shall begin construction or installation of a public water system, or make a substantial change in a public water system, until plans therefore have been approved by the director of environmental protection under division (A)(1) or (2) of this section." Paragraph (C) of the same chapter states "No person shall operate a public water system, and no person who is an owner of a public water system shall permit its operation, if the person knows or has reason to know that the system was constructed or installed, or that a substantial change was made in the system, in violation of division (A) or (B) of this section unless the person has obtained written authorization from the director to operate the system pursuant to division (D) of this section."

Mark Verbsky from this office has sent letters on three occasions requesting the necessary information to compete the plan review process; the most recent letter was dated October 26, 2007. We have yet to receive any response from you regarding this issue.

This matter requires your immediate attention. Failure to respond and correct these violations may result in formal enforcement action being taken by this office. Please contact me immediately at (937) 285-6114 to arrange a meeting so that we may discuss what is needed to complete the plan review process.
