Dear Mr. Wagner:

We are in receipt of your self-monitoring report covering the months of October 2007, through November 2007, for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance are attached on a separate sheet.

This letter also serves as notice that we have not received your December 2007, self-monitoring report. As a reminder, hard copy self-monitoring report submissions are due on the 15th day of the following month and electronic submissions are due on the 20th day of the following month. Submit your December 2007, report **within 10 days** of the date of this letter.

Further review of our records indicates that you no longer have an operator in responsible charge of the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) serving your facility. Your discharge permit requires that you have a Class I state certified operator in charge of the WWTP. You will need to complete and submit the enclosed form **within 30 days** of the date of this letter. Send one copy of the form to the address on the form and send one copy to this office at my attention.


Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations and/or monitoring requirements, including adequate laboratory controls, appropriate quality assurance procedures, and records retention, as specified in your Part III-General conditions of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 6111. If these violations continue to occur and if satisfactory progress is not made, it may be necessary to initiate enforcement action to achieve compliance.
