Dear Mr. Simon:

A review of your discharge monitoring reports for the referenced facility covering the months of December 2008, through January 2011, indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance are as follows:

Table with 5 columns: PERMIT, OUTFALL, DATE, PARAMETER, REPORTED, LIMITATION. Rows include August 2009 and September 2009 data for Fecal coliform and Suspended Solids.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations and/or monitoring requirements, including adequate laboratory controls, appropriate quality assurance procedures, and records retention, as specified in Part III - General Conditions of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 6111. If these violations continue to occur and if satisfactory progress is not made, it may be necessary to initiate enforcement action to achieve compliance.


