WARNING LETTER

Dear Mrs. Gehron:

On March 20, 2012, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) was contacted by the Laura Fire Department regarding the open burning of furniture, carpet, and trash at 400 Short Street, Laura, OH. An incident report from the Laura Fire Department was also received on March 20, 2012. The open burning of furniture, carpet, and trash in a restricted area is strictly prohibited.

This open burning is a violation of the following regulations:

- 1) Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule: 3745-19-03, Open Burning in a Restricted Area.
- 2) Miami County Board of Health Local Air Pollution Control Regulations (MCBHLAPCR) rule: 3745-19-03, Open Burning in a Restricted Area.


