Dear Mr. Cupp:

A review of the self-monitoring reports for the referenced facility covering the months of August 1, 2006, through June 30, 2011, indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of noncompliance are enclosed on a separate table.

It appears that this facility will have an Oil and Grease violation on a regular basis, at least annually. I would advise that you perform regular maintenance on the oil/water separator instead of waiting until after there is a violation.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations and/or monitoring requirements, including adequate laboratory controls, appropriate quality assurance procedures, and records retention, as specified in Part III - General Conditions of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 6111. If these violations continue to occur and if satisfactory progress is not made, it may be necessary to initiate enforcement action to achieve compliance.

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention


