This will acknowledge our June 3, 2011, compliance inspection at your Carey facility. This facility is located on 1794 County Road 99, Carey. This inspection was conducted as part of the renewal process for the facility's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit No. 2IJ00068 (OH0058467).

At the time of the inspection, the two quarry dewatering pumps were operational and the discharge from Outfall 001 appeared to have a slightly greenish tint. When a discharge occurs from the pond, it must be sampled in accordance with this NPDES permit.

Our review of your Discharge Monitoring Reports (5/2009 to 5/2011) for this facility indicated a few effluent violations. Please refer to the enclosed violation table. A completed inspection report is included for your review. If you have any questions or comments, please call me at 419-373-3021.


