Dear Mr. Foreman:

Thank you for your August 3 and 7, and October 10, 2012 emailed responses to Ohio EPA's July 26, 2012 Notice of Violation letter. Your responses included photographs of the excavated oily soils and a properly labeled used oil drum, a receipt for disposal of the oily soils at Sidwell Materials, and lastly, receipts from Waste Management's Suburban Landfill for disposal of oily soils that had been previously disposed of at Sidwell Materials and then re-excavated by Guernsey Scrap. Soils were re-excavated because Sidwell Materials is licensed to accept construction and demolition debris (C&DD) and asbestos, but not solid waste such as your oily soils.

Please be aware that any oily soils generated by your company in the future must be disposed of only at a licensed municipal waste solid landfill.

You have now abated all violations previously cited as a result of the July 23, 2012 inspection.

Enclosed please find a list of companies that can recycle wood pallets.
