On November 18, 2010, an inspection of the above referenced facility's wastewater treatment system was conducted. No one was present during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate the operation and maintenance of the treatment system along with the facility's compliance status with respect to the terms and conditions of the above referenced National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

During the inspection, the following items were noted:

1. The facility appears to be closed and the wastewater treatment system was not operating.
2. The last electronic discharge monitoring report received by this office was for November 2007.
3. Monthly operating reports are required to be submitted even if no discharge is occurring. The electronic discharge monitoring reports for the period December 2007 up to the present date should be submitted immediately. Failure to submit reports for the referenced time period is a violation of the NPDES permit.
4. The reporting code "AL" should be used each month when no discharge has occurred from the treatment system.
5. The facility's NPDES permit expires March 31, 2011.
6. In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the above date of expiration, the permittee is required to submit the appropriate renewal forms as required by the Ohio EPA no later than 180 days prior to the above date of expiration. Please note that a \$ 200.00 dollar application renewal fee is required at the time of submission. The check shall be made payable to: "Treasurer, State of Ohio"

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To avoid enforcement by this Agency, you must schedule a meeting with the Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office no later than January 31, 2011 to submit the NPDES permit application forms and \$ 200.00 application fee.

The NPDES permit General Form 1 and the appropriate supporting application forms (Form 2E, and 2S and Anti Degradation Addendum) have been enclosed for your use. These forms must be submitted and brought with you to the meeting.

Please be advised that such instances of noncompliance may be cause for enforcement actions pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 6111.
