NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Evans:

An inspection was conducted by the undersigned of the sanitary wastewater treatment plant serving the above referenced facility on September 6, 2007. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate the facility's compliance status with respect to the terms and conditions of the above-referenced National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

The inspection noted that the business was closed with a "For Sale" sign attached to the building. The wastewater treatment system was turned off. The treatment system improvements, required to be constructed by June 30, 2006, had not been installed.

An inventory review covering the period September 2006 through August 2007 noted that Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) required by the above referenced NPDES permit were not submitted by your facility. The reports are generally required to be submitted by no later than the 15th day of the following month. Specifically, the review noted that reports were not submitted for the following months:


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Based on the above information, the facility is considered to be in **significant noncompliance** with the terms and conditions of the NPDES permit and, therefore, subject to enforcement actions pursuant to Chapter 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code. Such actions can result in fines of up to \$10,000 per day of violation as well as the formal revocation of the NPDES permit.

Please inform this office, in writing, as to the actions that have been or will be taken to correct the above violations and/or deficiencies. Your response should include the dates that the actions will be completed. Please be advised that past or present issues of noncompliance can continue as subjects of future enforcement actions by Ohio EPA.
