Dear Ms. Bingman:

This letter confirms a visit by the Hebron Fire Department to your property on October 2, 2012, wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 707 South Street, Hebron, you were open burning furniture and rubbish. Additionally, this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises and also within a restricted area.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
