Dear Mr. Coon:

You are hereby cited for violations of the Ohio Administrative Code section 3745-17-08 (B)(1) (Fugitive Dust) and Title 9 Section 97.01 of the Akron Code of Ordinances. These violations have occurred at various job sites in the City of Akron (Summit County).

On April 26, 2007 an inspector from the Akron Regional Air Quality Management District observed excessive fugitive dust being generated at 57 S. Broadway Street in the City of Akron. The dust was the result of saw cutting cement block without water to suppress the dust. At this time, contact was made, the fugitive dust regulations were explained, and written orders to "cease and desist" all illegal sawing/cutting activities were issued.

On June 11, 2007 an Akron Regional Air Quality Management District inspector again observed fugitive dust at 57 S. Broadway as a result of saw cutting cement block without water or any method of dust suppression. At this time, contact was made and a second written order to "cease and desist" all illegal sawing/cutting activities was issued.

On June 28, 2007 an inspector from the Akron Regional Air Quality Management District observed workers from AmeriSeal sawing brick while using water to control the dust. The inspector went onsite and commended the two workers on doing an excellent job controlling the dust.

On September 20, 2007 an inspector from the Akron Regional Air Quality Management District observed workers from AmeriSeal sawing brickwork at 1115 S. Main Street, Akron, Ohio. The sawing occurred on the south side of the building facing Miller Avenue, and no dust control was being utilized.


On August 7 & 8, 2008 an inspector from the Akron Regional Air Quality Management District observed a worker from AmeriSeal grinding mortar from joints without dust control. This violation occurred at the A.C.&Y. building, 12 E. Exchange Street, in the City of Akron. At this time, contact was made and written orders were again issued.

In light of this most recent violation, you are urged to take appropriate steps to be sure that no further illegal generation of fugitive dust occurs on this job site or any others. **Within seven (7) days of receipt of this letter, please submit a written commitment to cease all further illegal generation of fugitive dust.**

Acceptance by this Agency of your commitment does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Title 9 Section 97.01 of the Akron Code of Ordinances, or to refer the matter to the Ohio EPA for their enforcement action (including imposition of civil penalties). The determination to pursue or to decline to pursue such penalties will be made at a later date.
