Annual District Report – Second Notice of Violation**

Dear Mr. Reed:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Pike County Solid Waste Management District (District) continues to be in violation of section 3745-27-90(F) of the Ohio Administrative Code for failing to submit an annual report by June 1, 2011. Specifically, section 3745-27-90(F) of the Administrative Code states:

Solid waste management districts shall submit an annual district report on a form prescribed by the director not later than the first day of June each year.

In June 2011, the District received a notice of violation letter directing the District to respond with a schedule for submitting its completed annual district report for 2010 (2010 ADR). The District responded that it anticipated submitting the completed report by July 15, 2011. As of the date of this correspondence, Ohio EPA had not received the District's completed 2010 ADR.

After receiving this letter, please contact Matthew Hittle and provide a date by which the District will submit its completed 2010 ADR.

Please be advised that failure to rectify this violation in a timely manner may subject the District to escalated enforcement action. We appreciate your cooperation in resolving this matter quickly.
