RE: Notice of Violation of OAC § 3745-19 at Noramco Transport Company

Dear Mr. Roddy:

This agency received a complaint of open burning at Noramco Transport Company, 6th and Harriet Rail Yard. During our field investigation on May 24, 2007 we found evidence of open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code § 3745-19. The investigator was told that the fire was for cleaning up the area. Brian Cutter of KDM indicated it was a recognized means of disposal at the site.

Hamilton County Environmental Services solicits your cooperation in terminating any illegal open burning. At this time, HCDOES requests from Noramco Transport Company a written statement that all personnel at the facility will suspend all illegal burning. Please send this to HCDOES by no later than June 8, 2007.


Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of this information does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. Failure to comply with the requirements of this letter may result in additional enforcement action including possible referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General. The violations identified above also constitute a violation of Warren County Combined Health District rules. Warren County Combined Health District rules are enforced by the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services.
