Madison Township, Butler County, OH


Dear Mr. Saylor:

This agency received a complaint of open burning at your property near 6250 Germantown Road, Madison Township, Butler County. The property is identified as Parcel ID E22 100 2100 0068. During our field investigation on July 16, 2007 we found evidence of open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code § 3745-19.

No fires are allowed to be set less than one thousand feet from the nearest neighbors' inhabited building. In addition, no fires for waste disposal may be set unless permission is obtained from the Ohio EPA. Fires must be attended at all times. Hamilton County Environmental Services solicits your cooperation in terminating any illegal open burning.

Failure to comply with the requirements of this letter may result in additional enforcement action including possible referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General. The violations identified above also constitute a violation of Butler County Health Department rules. Butler County Health Department rules are enforced by the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services.
