RE: WARNING LETTER FOR OPEN BURNING IN VIOLATION OF OAC 3745-19-03.

Dear Mr. Orling:


On September 26, 2007 Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services received a complaint of open burning at your property at 2815 Colerain Avenue. An agency investigator documented a resident burning insulation from copper wire. The resident, Lee Holmes, was given a verbal warning and was advised to put the fire out.

Please be advised that the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) prohibits open burning within one thousand feet of any inhabited building not located on your premises. The burning of any materials containing rubber, grease, asphalt or liquid petroleum products is prohibited in all areas. You are advised to suspend any open burning at your Colerain Avenue property.

Failure to comply with the requirements of this letter may result in additional enforcement action including possible referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General. The violations identified above also constitute a violation of City of Cincinnati Health Department rules. City of Cincinnati Health Department rules are enforced by the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services.

The violations identified above also constitute a violation of Title X, City of Cincinnati Municipal Code. Title X is enforced by the City Solicitor's Office. The City Solicitor's Office has requested that this agency notify them of all Title X violations identified by this agency. Consequently, a copy of this Notice of Violation has been sent to the City Solicitor's Office.
