RE: WARNING LETTER FOR VIOLATIONS OF OHIO OPEN BURNING
STANDARDS - OAC 3745-19-04

Dear Mr. Morgan:


On June 13, Salem-Morrow Fire Department reported open burning at your residence, at 2247 Moore Saur Road, in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) § 3745-19-04. The report states that materials were being burned, including foam insulation, flotation devices, and furniture, that are prohibited by the OAC. This agency confirmed that those items were burned at your residence. You are advised to suspend all open burning in violation of OAC 3745-19-04.

Be advised that failure to comply with the requirements of this letter may result in additional enforcement action, including possible referral of this case to the Office of the Ohio Attorney General. Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of a compliance plan does not constitute a waiver of the EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The determination to pursue or to decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by the Ohio EPA at a later date. The violations identified above also constitute a violation of Warren County Combined Health District rules. Warren County Combined Health District rules are enforced by the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services.
