RE: WRITTEN WARNING OF FUGITIVE DUST RULE - OAC 3745-17-08(B) AND  
3745-17-07

Dear Mr. Bridges:

The Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services (HCDOES) has received complaints regarding dust from the construction site on North Bend Crossing Rd. A HCDOES Compliance Specialist visited the site on three occasions following citizens' complaints on October 10, October 22, and October 23, 2008.

Violations of the fugitive dust rules found in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) § 3745-17-08(B) and 3745-17-07 were identified during the site visit on October 23, 2008. Agency inspectors noted that the North Bend Crossing Road was dry and dusty and inadequate dust control was being used at the site. Method 22 readings were taken on North Bend Crossing Road. Over six minutes of fugitive dust was recorded in thirty minutes of observation.

HCDOES finds that you are in violation of OAC § 3745-17-08(B), *Restriction of Emissions of Fugitive Dust*. **HCDOES requests that you submit a compliance plan, with details of a control strategy to minimize dust emissions from current and future sites. An acceptable plan will include specifics of the dust control strategy and a timeline for implementation. This plan should be received not later than seven days following receipt of this correspondence.**



Be advised that failure to comply with the requirements of this letter may result in additional enforcement action, including possible referral of this case to the Office of the Ohio Attorney General. Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of a compliance plan does not constitute a waiver of the EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or to decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by the Ohio EPA at a later date.

The violations identified above also constitute a violation of Hamilton County General Health District rules. Hamilton County General Health District air pollution rules are enforced by the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services.
