Dear Ms. Page:

This letter shall serve as follow-up to The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Northwest District Office (NWDO), Division of Air Pollution Control's September 19, 2012, attempted inspections of three properties located at 138 South Main Street, Mansfield, Ohio 44902, 115 Benton, Mansfield, Ohio 44902, and 296 Glessner Avenue, Mansfield, Ohio 44902. Upon arriving at these sites for inspection it was found that no asbestos stripping or removal work was being completed.

Ohio EPA's rules regarding asbestos stripping or removal work in any subject demolition or renovation that will begin on a date other than contained in the original notice are contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-20. Specifically, OAC rule 3745-20-03(A)(3)(d) requires when the asbestos stripping or removal operation or demolition operation covered by this paragraph that will begin after the date contained in the notice, notification is required to the Ohio EPA field office of the new start date by telephone as soon as possible before the original start date, and postmark or deliver to the Ohio EPA field office a written notice of the new start date as soon as possible before, and no later than the original start date. Delivery of the amended notice shall be by the United States postal service, commercial delivery, or hand delivery.

This notice of violation is being issued for the following:

1. Violation of OAC rule 3745-20-03(A)(3)(d) "Standard for notification prior to demolition or renovation," for failure to notify the Ohio EPA field office by telephone of the new start date before the original start date and failure to postmark or deliver a written notice by the original start date.
