Dear Mr. Cox:

I am writing this letter in response to a complaint received by this office on March 6, 2012. The complaint alleges that you burn trash, plastics and metal at your home.

On March 9, 2012, I investigated this complaint and spoke to you about open burning on this property. You told me that you take your trash to your landlord's residence for disposal, but that you have burned plastic-coated copper wire at the Maysville Williams Road property. As I explained at that time, plastics and plastic-coated copper wire cannot be open burned anywhere in Ohio.

Open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. I gave you a pamphlet that explains this rule. All open burning in violation of the requirements specified in OAC rule 3745-19-04 must stop immediately. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials at this location, legal action may be taken against you.
