NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Taghavi:

This confirms our conversation of October 29, 2012 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 2250 Parson Avenue, Columbus, Ohio, you were open burning a warming fire that was larger than allowed by rule. Your fire was approximately 3 ½ feet by 5 feet and the rule allows a fire 3 feet in diameter by 2 feet high fuel area.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
