Dear Mr. Overton:


On October 22, 2007, in response to an open burning complaint, I observed the remains of burned and partially burned waste materials at the property located at 1850 Bailey Road, North Jackson Ohio 44451, Mahoning County. As I explained to you businesses are not permitted to open burn in the State of Ohio for waste disposal purposes. Be advised that the open burning that was being conducted on your property on October 20, 2007 was in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-04 (enclosed) open burning in unrestricted areas. Therefore, all open burning being conducted in violation of the regulations above must cease immediately.

Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-06(A) provides that the director of Ohio EPA may assess and collect, through unilateral orders, civil penalties of not more than one thousand dollars per day for each separate violation of the open burning rules that occurs on industrial, commercial, institutional or municipal property.

Be advised that this warning letter does not constitute a waiver of MTAPCA'S ability to pursue further enforcement action through Ohio EPA concerning this or any other violations or to seek penalties as provided in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3704.
