Ms. Myers,

On June 29, 2011, the Mahoning-Trumbull Air Pollution Control Agency (M-TAPCA) received a complaint concerning open burning of trash for waste disposal in 250 gallon oil tank in the back yard. On June 30, 2011 this writer visited the above referenced property and observed the 250 gallon tank with what appeared to be burned miscellaneous debris around the area in question.


Please be advised that that you are not permitted to open burn in the State of Ohio for waste disposal purposes. Open burning in a restricted area for waste disposal purposes is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03. Therefore, all open burning being conducted in violation of the above regulations must cease immediately.

Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-06(A) provides that the director of Ohio EPA may assess and collect, through unilateral orders, civil penalties of not more than one thousand dollars per day for each separate violation of the open burning rules that occurs on industrial, commercial, institutional or municipal property.

Be advised that this warning letter does not constitute a waiver of MTAPCA's ability to pursue further enforcement action through Ohio EPA concerning this or any other violations or to seek penalties as provided in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3704.
