

OAC rule 3745-273-14(A), Labeling/marketing Standards for Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste: RET3's October 26 and November 2 responses included photographs and labels which showed the universal waste containers were labeled in compliance with this rule. <b>Based upon submitted documentation, this violation has been adequately addressed.</b>
3.	OAC Rule 3745-273-15(C), Accumulation Time Limits - Standards For Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste: RET3's October 26 response indicated that universal waste batteries will be shipped off-site within 90-days to a downstream vendor. <b>Based upon submitted documentation, this violation has been adequately addressed.</b>
