Dear Mr. Lang:

Thank you for your October 23 and November 8, 2012 responses to Ohio EPA's September 20, 2012 Notice of Violation letter. Your responses included a description and photographs of areas of ground where used oil and diesel fuel were excavated and where a burn pile was removed; a description of steps taken to clean up oil spillage in your shop and properly label used oil tanks/containers; a landfill receipt for excavated soils; and a description of your employee training program for fueling and handling of leaks and spills. In addition I received a sign in sheet indicating that employees had been trained in the aforementioned program. I also conducted a follow-up inspection on October 26, 2012 to ascertain that used oils and fuels had been properly cleaned up.

Based on the above, Larry Lang Excavating has now abated all violations discovered during the September 12, 2012 inspection.
