Dear Mr. Allen:

On October 12, 2012, Ohio EPA received a complaint alleging that used oil was being released at the DSI Underground Systems Inc. (DSI) facility. On October 17, 2012, I performed a complaint investigation to determine the validity of the complaint and to determine DSI's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code (respectively).

We observed that used-oil was leaking from the containment around the #2 Header and a notice of violation letter was issued on October 19, 2012. On November 15, 2012, I received your emails with photographs showing that the #2 Header unit has been removed and the used oil cleaned up. Therefore, DSI has returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste regulation:

- 1) OAC rule 3745-279-22(B), Used oil storage requirements for generators.

You have now abated all violations cited from the October 17, 2012 compliance inspection.
