

Subject: Rescinding Violation – TCR

Dear Mr. Keifer:

Your public water system was issued a notice of violation of Rule 3745-81-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) on August 15, 2012 for the monitoring period of 2Q2012. The sample(s) was (were) collected on May 31, 2012 but the result was not reported correctly until August 29, 2012.

The violation has been rescinded and the public notice sent with the notice of violation referenced above does not need to be issued at this time.

OAC 3745-81-31 and 3745-89-08 require results to be reported by the tenth day following the month the sample was collected. Further, OAC 3745-89-08 requires the laboratory to report all positive, all repeat sample results and all samples required by OAC 3745-81-42 (Ground Water Rule) no later than the end of the next business day after the result was obtained. The sample(s) was (were) not reported in accordance with the above rules and this is considered a reporting violation.
