**Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water**

Bainbridge Township Police Station PWS is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-24 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the 2012 Annual monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES (TTHM), HALOACETIC ACIDS, FIVE (HAA5).

**In order to return to compliance**, Bainbridge Township Police Station PWS must take the following actions:

1. Immediately collect a sample of your drinking water from the maximum residence time (location in the systems where the age of the water is the oldest).
2. Submit the sample for analysis to a certified laboratory on the enclosed list.
3. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
4. Complete and return the enclosed verification form to this office.

Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated. Continued noncompliance may lead to enforcement actions. If you have any questions, or if the required sample analysis was performed, please call me at (614) 644-2752.

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Monitoring requirements not met for Bainbridge Township Police Station PWS

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the 2012 Annual time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time:*

TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES (TTHM), HALOACETIC ACIDS, FIVE (HAA5).

### What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Bainbridge Township Police Station PWS did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the 2012 Annual time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

### What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
