Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on March 10, 2011. You submitted this information in response to my March 2, 2011, Notice of Violation Letter. In your response letter, you included a copy of the service agreement you have recently signed with Allied Environmental Services, Inc. (AES) to dispose of your spent fluorescent light bulbs and other spent light bulbs. AES will be taken you spent light bulbs to Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green, Ohio, to be recycled. You will be managing your light bulbs as universal waste. Please remember to follow the universal waste rules as prescribed in the guidance document I previously provided you. You also included photographs showing the proper labeling of containers of used oil.

My review of this documentation reveals that Roeder Cartage Company, Inc. has abated the violations discovered during the February 16, 2011, complaint investigation/inspection as listed below:
